
WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes that in order to ensure the public's safety, preserve peace and order, and protect tribal resources, persons who are not subject to the criminal jurisdiction of the Warm Springs Tribal Court who violate the provisions of the Warm Springs Tribal Code should be subject to a civil penalty; and,

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has been advised that it is necessary to amend Chapter 200 (Courts) of the Warm Springs Tribal Code in order to subject such persons to civil penalties; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1(1) of the Constitution, that the attached Exhibit A, amending Chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code, is hereby approved and enacted.


CERTIFICATION

The undersigned, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held this 19th day of June, 1990, and that the foregoing resolution was passed by the affirmative vote of 6 members, and the Chairman not voting; and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
