

WHEREAS, Tribal Council Resolution No. 8281 adopted on July 9, 1991, amended Warm Springs Tribal Code Section 200.001 to defer the application of WSTC 200.100 "Civil Statute of Limitations" with regard to actions commenced by the Confederated Tribes, including its departments and enterprises, until after January 1, 1997; and,

WHEREAS, Current economic conditions, natural disasters resulting in economic losses to the Tribes and to tribal members and diversion of tribal resources have made it impractical to commence collections of all obligations owed to the Tribes and have immediate enforcement of such obligations not in the best interest of the Confederated Tribes and its members; and,

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes it is appropriate and fair to the Tribes and to those owing obligations to the Tribes to extend the time period in which action to collect may be commenced by the Confederated Tribes, its departments and enterprises for an additional period of three years now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, By the (20th) Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1 (f) and (1), of the Tribal Constitution that Warm Springs Tribal Code Chapter 200, Section 200.001 is amended to read as follows:

200.001. The provisions of WSTC 200.100 shall not apply to actions commenced by the Confederated Tribes, including its departments and enterprises until after January 1, 2000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Warm Springs Tribal Code Chapter 200, Section 200.001, as amended, shall be effective immediately.

CERTIFICATION

The undersigned as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members, of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, and convened and held this 23rd day of December, 1996, and that the foregoing resolution was passed by the affirmative vote of 5 members, 1 member abstaining, the chairman not voting; and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
