


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that a revision of the Warm Springs Law & Order Code, is necessary; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon that the attached Chapters 201 (Civil Procedures) and Chapter 202 (Criminal Procedures) of the Warm Springs Tribal Code is hereby adopted.

The undersigned, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members, of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held this 28th day of June, 1982, and that the foregoing resolution was passed by the affirmative vote of 6 members, the Chairman not voting and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
