CHAPTER 205
WARM SPRINGS TRIBAL TORT CLAIMS

Ordinance No.71

205.000 Enacting Statement

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-laws of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, the Tribal Council is charged with the duty to protect the health, security and general welfare of the members of the Confederated Tribes; manage the economic affairs of the Confederated Tribes; regulate the use and disposition of and protect and preserve Tribal property; and provide for the maintenance of law and order on the reservation; and

WHEREAS, parties may have claims to assert against the Confederated Tribes and should be provided a forum whereby they may be entitled to redress of just claims to which they are entitled under the law and in accordance with the orderly processes of the Confederated Tribes, while at the same time protecting the legitimate public interest of the Confederated Tribes and its members and the ability of the Tribal government to function without undue interference; and


WHEREAS, Tribal Council deems it appropriate to provide a process for asserting claims against the Confederated Tribes with appropriate limitations on recovery that can be had; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED, By the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1 (i) and (l) of the Constitution and By-Laws, that the following Ordinance No. 71, "Warm Springs Tribal Tort Claims," be and is hereby adopted as Warm Springs Tribal Code Chapter 205.


CERTIFICATION

The undersigned, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members, of whom 8 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held this 26th day of April, 1988; and that the foregoing ordinance was passed by the affirmative vote of 7 members, the chairman not voting; and that the said ordinance has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
