Resolution No. 8044

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes that the liquor violations offense in the Tribal Criminal Code should be decriminalized and made subject only to civil penalties; and,

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council believes that decriminalizing liquor violations will better enable the Tribe to ensure the public's safety and maintain law and order on the Reservation by enforcing with civil penalties liquor violations against all persons residing on and visiting the Reservation, and


WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has determined that it is necessary to amend the Warm Springs Tribal Code in order to decriminalize liquor violations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Constitution that the attached Chapter 307 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code entitled "Liquor Violations" is hereby approved and enacted; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1(1) of the Constitution that Section 305.457 of the Criminal Code concerning liquor violations is hereby repealed.
