

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Warm Springs Community and the enrolled members of the Warm Springs Tribe that the Tribal Court be empowered to order the emergency detention of mentally ill persons under procedures established by the Tribal Council and set out in the Tribal Code; and,


WHEREAS, The attached Chapter 330 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code empowers the Tribal Court to order the emergency detention of mentally ill persons and sets out the procedures to be followed for issuance of such orders; now, therefore


BE IT RESOLVED, By the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article IV, Section T of the Constitution, that the attached Chapter 330 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code dealing with "Emergency Detention of Mentally Ill Persons" is hereby adopted; and

CERTIFICATION

The undersigned, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members, of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held this 1st day of October, 1983; and that the foregoing resolution was passed by the affirmative vote of 6 members, the Chairman not voting; and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
